

## **2019-2020 NNHS Tiger Permit Application Process**

**Applications must be post marked no later than August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.**

**Applications must be sent to:**

**Each student must send in the following:**

- Application (signed by student and parent/guardian)
- Photo copy of student's driver's license (not permit)
- Photo copy of vehicle registration (that Tiger Permit will be for)
- Check for \$25.00 payable to the City of Newton
- **Self-addressed and stamped legal size envelope**

**All senior applicants will be assigned Tiger Permits first**

- If we receive more than 150 senior applicants, we will use a random drawing system to assign each permit
- If we receive less than 150 senior applicants, the balance will be filled at random from the juniors who have applied.

We will issue Tiger Permits to the students via U.S. Mail (in self-addressed envelope).

Any students that applied, but will not receive a Tiger Permit will have their check returned to them via U.S. Mail.
