WARNING

18-year-old female accosted/assaulted & battered while waiting at the bus stop, at the intersection of Centre Street and Church Street.

The Newton Police Department is reporting that at approximately 5:30 PM on Monday October 12, 2009 an 18-year-old female was waiting at the bus stop, at the intersection of Centre Street and Church Street, when a male driving southbound on Centre Street pulled up next to her. The male asked if she wanted to hang out and to get into his vehicle, which the female refused. This male then pulled his vehicle over to the side of the road, got out and approached her. He grabbed her firmly on the shoulders and asked her if she wanted to "****." The female broke free from his grasp and ran up Centre Street with the suspect following her, now in his vehicle. The female was able to hail a cab and the suspect drove off.

According to the victim, she again observed this suspect two more times after this incident, while at the same bus stop. The first was on Tuesday October 13, 2009 between 5:30 and 6:00 PM and again on Thursday October 15, 2009. On both occasions and he beeped and waved to her as he drove by.

The suspect is described as being a white male in his 20's, approximately 6' 2" tall, shoulder length brown/blond hair, light colored eyes, pale skin and slender build. At the time of the first incident, he was wearing a black jacket, white tee shirt and blue jeans. Suspect vehicle is described as an older model 4 door white sedan/wagon with an Obama bumper sticker on the right rear window.
